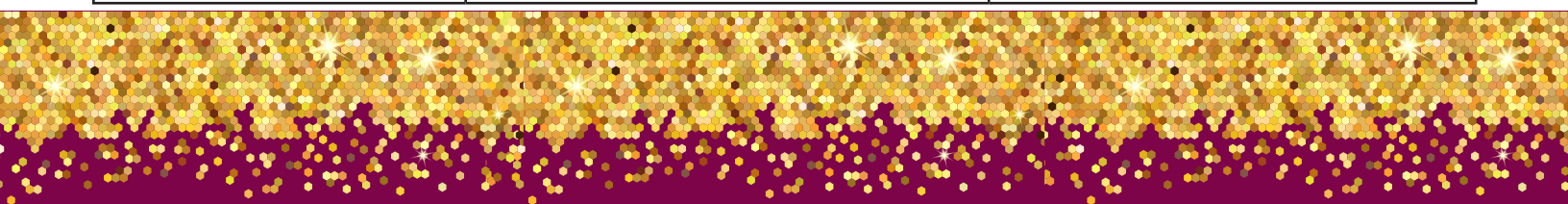


2017 YouthLive! Gala Volunteer Recruitment

Volunteer Positions	Duties	Time Commitment
Fashion Show	Work with staff to solicit appropriate clothiers for the fashion show.	Monthly 1 hr meetings with staff Feb-April + 2 hrs to complete task list and follow-up.
Live Auction	Work with staff to secure donations for 4-5 premiere live auction items/packages as well as items for the Treasure Chest.	Monthly 1 hr meetings Jan-April + 3 hrs to complete task list and follow-up.
Table/Ticket Sales	Reach out to local businesses and individuals for table or ticket purchase.	Monthly 1 hr meetings Feb-April + 4 hrs to complete task list and follow-up.
Treasure Chest	Work with staff to secure donations to insert into the Treasure Chest. Recruit and lead an outgoing volunteer team of 6-8 key sellers to ensure all 100 keys are sold at the gala.	Monthly 1 hr meetings Jan-April + 3 hrs to complete task list and follow-up.
Youth Art Auction	Works with staff to host art workshops for foster youth, select and organize pieces for the silent auction, and bid sheets.	Bi-Monthly 1 hr workshops Feb-April + 2 hrs.
Youth Talent Recruitment	Help recruit top local youth talent to audition and perform at the gala.	Monthly 1 hr meetings Feb-April + 2 hrs to complete task list and follow-up.
